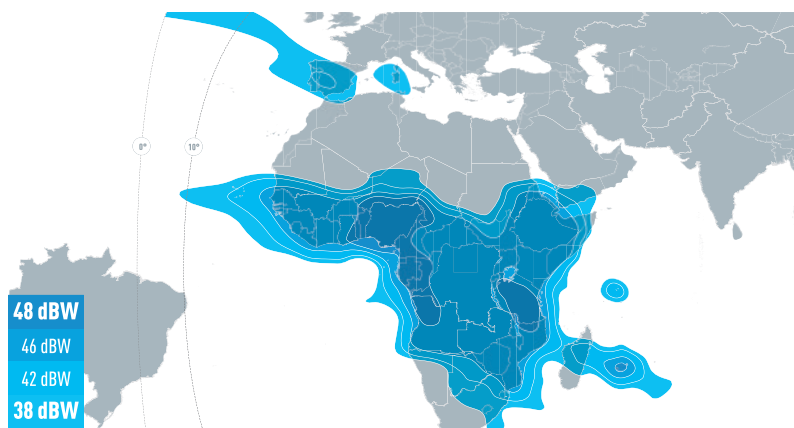


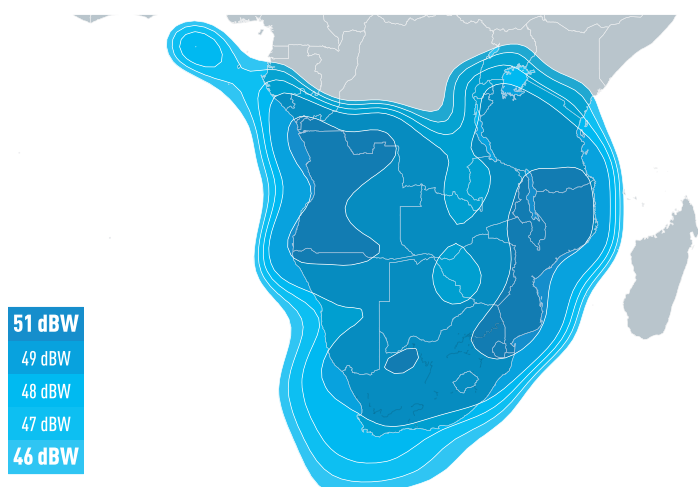

With two powerful satellites, co-located for in-orbit redundancy and security, EUTELSAT 36C and EUTELSAT 36D provide extensive Sub-Saharan coverage with up to 51 dBW for pan-African DTH services.

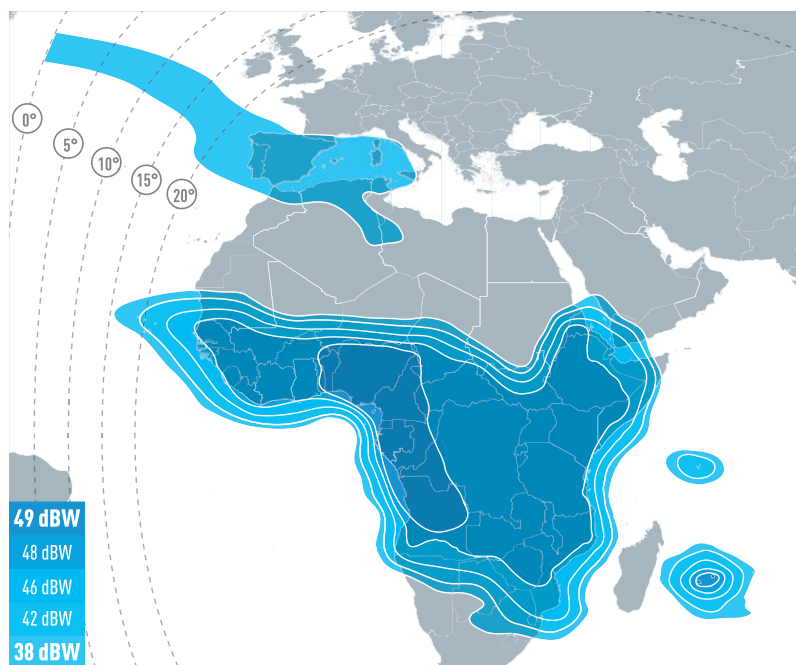
Chosen by leading pay-TV platforms, DStv and ZAP, 560 TV channels, 100 in HD, are broadcast to over 7 million TV homes across the continent.

The high capacity satellites, provide service continuity and growth for broadcast markets in Sub-Saharan Africa. With powerful coverage for pan-African DTH services, the state-of-the-art satellites are transforming the broadcasting infrastructure at 36° East into a broader system to support more television services at this key orbital location for TV broadcasting in Africa.
